Topic: Wing flare to meet Main Wheel

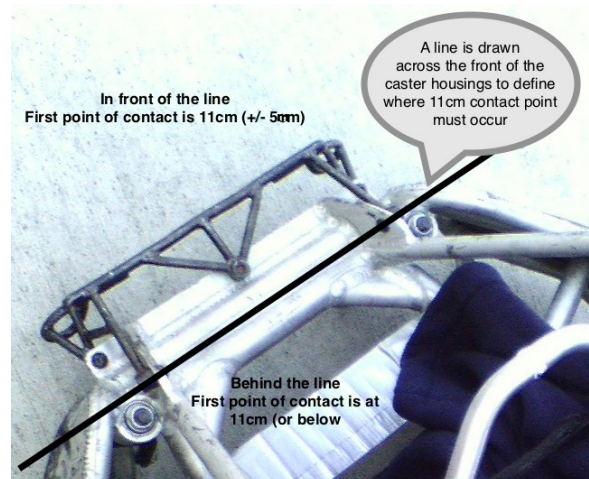
The Equipment Committee was asked to review the wing below the 11 centimeter point as it flares out to meet the main wheel.

It has been brought to the attention of the committee that on some chairs the first point of contact on the wing as you approach the main wheel is not at the 11 cm point, but towards the bottom of the wing.

Upon review the committee has advised that they can see no advantage being gained from this and thus have ruled that if the wing is legal in all other respects – the first point of contact may occur below the 11 cm contact point between the caster housing and the main wheel

To define the area where the first point of contact may occur on the wing below the 11 cm the following applies.

1. First point of contact must be 11 cm (\pm 5mm) in front of the caster housing.
2. Wing must not extend passed the center of the tire on the main wheel
3. First point of contact on the wing behind the caster housing must be at 11 cm or below.
